By entering and participating in a Saddle & Harness Association, Inc. (the "Club") Event and signing this Waiver Agreement (the "Agreement") as the Owner, Lessee, Driver, Rider, Driver or Handler and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of Saddle & Harness Association, Inc. (collectively, the "Rules"). I agree to be bound by the Rules of the Club and I will accept as final the decision of the Board of Director ("Board") or the Show Committee (the "Committee") on any question arising under the Rules. I agree to release and hold harmless the Event, the Club, the Board, the Committee, their officials, directors and employees (collectively, the "Indemnified Parties") for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every equine I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that, as a condition of, and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Club may use or assign photographs, videos, audios or other likenesses of me and my equine taken during the course of the Event for the promotion, coverage or for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Event or the Club. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Rules are governed by the laws of the State of California, and any action instituted against the Club must be filed in the County of Riverside, State of California.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Event with my equine, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that equine activities such as the Event involve inherently dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm");

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my equine and to release, indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) and hold harmless, the Indemnified Parties with respect to claims for Harm to me or my equine, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my equine at the Event, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Indemnified Parties.

I AGREE to I have read the Club Rules about protective equipment and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Club strongly encourages me to do so.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the junior exhibitor's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions, AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf and acknowledge that the Rules specifically require the use of protective helmets for junior exhibitors.

I AGREE that, if I am injured at this Event, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Indemnified Parties.
